Acceptance Bracelets MEANINGS

- Red—Courage
To stand up and do the right thing others are not
- Blue—Truth
Always be honest
- White—Integrity
Do the right thing even when nobody is looking
- Green---Well-Being
Take care of yourself & your body. Treat it with respect
- Yellow—Wisdom
Work hard so others seek your wisdom/guidance for help
- Black—Stability
Be grounded. Do right thing in/outside school. Be that Role Model 24/7

GAMES AND ACTIVITIES

1. Puzzle missing Piece—explain “give every student one piece of puzzle as they enter the room except one piece. Put puzzle together. Remind kids that all of us are important. One piece missing we/activity is not complete.
2. Big Cards on Head --treat each other according to the number and line up in the order. Do not look at cards on your head
3. Letter Spell—explain (cut out letters and have kids spell the words. One letter per student.
4. Closet lights—explain use to “hit a buzzer/answer”
5. Peek A Who Sheet game to know names
6. Noodles & Marker writing
7. Cone Head Game
8. Wind Bags from Spangler—must stand back to blow up completely
9. PVC Pipeline—skinny alleys
10. PVC Pipeline—big alleys
11. Puzzles—explain communication games of giving directions to put together
