Your registration fee includes all sessions, conference materials and membership, dinner Friday night, luncheon Saturday and a full breakfast Sunday morning. The Regular Registration fee is \$325. Onsite Registration and late registration (after November 15) is \$350.

There are several options for reduced conference registration fees:

- **Early Bird Registration** - (\$295) Register online and pay online or mail your online confirmation and your check postmarked no later than October 31, 2011. Regular conference rates apply to everyone who misses the October 31 Early Bird Rate but does register no later than November 28.
- **Group Rate** - (\$275 per person) Get a group of five or more together. Make sure each person registers online and includes the names of the other members in your group. Mail ALL registration confirmations AND checks or online payment confirmations in one envelope postmarked no later than October 31, 2011.
- **NASSCED Early Bird Rate** - (\$275) Delegates to the National Association of State Student Council Executive Directors who are attending their meetings before the National Conference on Student Activities will also qualify for a reduced rate if they get their materials and payments in by October 31.

Payment Options

- ✓ You may pay by school or personal check. The check and a copy of your online registration confirmation must be mailed no later than November 15. (October 31 to qualify for the Early Bird Rate)
- ✓ You may also pay by credit card through PayPal. Those registering between November 15 and November 28 must use the PayPal option or pay the onsite registration fee.
- ✓ Those registering onsite must pay by cash or check.
- ✓ Sorry, we do not accept purchase orders.
- ✓ Requests for a partial refund must be in writing and received no later than November 21.
