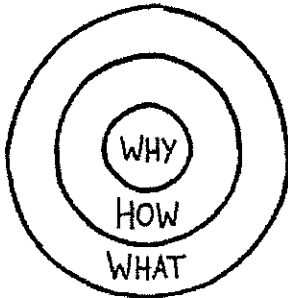

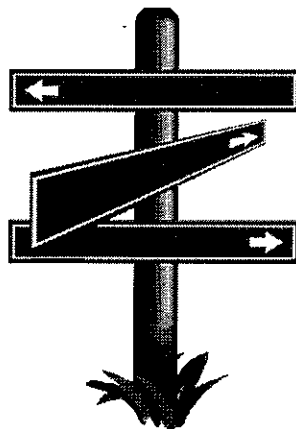

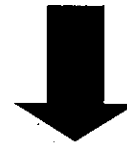
**WHAT DOES IT MEAN?**
