Materials Needed:

Zip lock sandwich bags (40 per package for \$.97) – 6 ½ in. x 5 7/8 in.

Clothespins (100 per package for \$.97)

Small squiggle eyes (60 per package for \$.97)

Pipe Cleaners (100 per package for \$2.97) enough for 300 butterflies

Sequins (10 packages for \$1.97)

Gemstones (145 for \$1.97)

Paint (matte acrylic – 2 fl. Oz. for \$.50)

Glue Stick/scissors/toothpicks

Candy - I used gumballs (42 per butterfly at \$7.00 per pkg. gumballs)

Instructions: Paint the clothespins the color(s) of your choice & let dry.

Using glue stick, attach two eyes & 3 sequins or 3 gemstones. Cut and shape pipe cleaners length and form that you want them – attach using glue sticks. Place candy of your choice into bag.

(I use 42 pieces per bag – one bag fills 25 butterflies.) Squeeze in center of bag and attach clothespin. This project is easy and inexpensive to do as the materials purchased will create a large number of butterflies. (cost about \$.40 per butterfly)
