DESCRIPTION: Learn how to make a boo boo bunny that your students can donate to hospitals, clinics or non-profit agencies.



### **BOO BOO BUNNIES:**

Boo Boo Bunnies are one simple way you can give back to your community while having fun doing a craft project with your students!

To make a boo boo bunny you will need: a washcloth, rubber band, pom-poms, wiggle eyes, ribbon, craft glue, and scissors.

To make a Boo Boo Bunny you:

- 1) fold the rag in half so that it looks like a triangle



- 2) Starting at the top point of the wash cloth begin to tightly roll the wash cloth.
- 3) Once you have rolled the entire rag fold it in half.



4) Fold it in half again.



5) Put a rubber band around the washcloth creating the circle that will become the bunny's head.



6) Fluff up the edges of the cloth to make them look like the rabbits ears.

7) Glue on the wiggle eyes and a small pom pom to make the bunny's face. Tie a ribbon around the bunny's neck to cover the rubber band and make it cute.

8) Glue a one inch pom pom on the back of the bunny as a tail

You now have made a Boo Boo Bunny! These are not only cute, but are perfect for hurt children to put an ice cubes in and hold over their boo boos!
